- 1) Full-time Day Academy: Our fall academy runs January 13, 2025 through beginning of May, 2025. Classes meet Mon-Sat from 8 am until 4:30 pm.

The tuition for the academy is \$5,600(includes a \$200 registration fee).

The Basic Police Academy is V.A. approved, so eligible students can use their Montgomery G.I.Bill or Post 9/11 benefits. Please provide a copy of your DD214 Form with your completed application packet.

If you interested in becoming a Summit County Sheriff's Deputy, they are hiring cadets and paying for them to attend the academy if hired. You will also get paid while attending the academy.
