Background

In light of legal concerns relative to the regulatory definition of-that must employment for-If students, the Office of General Counsel and the nternational Center had previously determined that students-in-Ifatus must apply for Curricular Practical Training (CPT) auttation to work offeampusat a sponsoring company, even though the dent was receiving payment from UA.

However, the CPT mechanism that rawbacks, namely:

- x cumbersome implementation (i.e., several rounds of band forth paperwork between the department, employer, Office of Research Administration, the Office of General Counsel and the International Center);
- x regulatorylimitation that F-1 students enroll fultime for one academic year before becoming eligible for, **CHRIS** limiting the CIGA opportunity during this critical figstar,
- x requirementthat F-1 students enroll in a creditearing course associate with the CPT each semester; and
- x the possibility that government guidance relating to CPT may change at any point under the current administration.

Current Policy
